

Environmental Science 21 Working Group

As requested by school divisions, the ministry will facilitate a gathering of teachers to develop modified (basic) course outlines and resource packages which school divisions may elect to adopt. A call for teachers to participate in *Science 11*, *Health Science 21*, *Environmental Science 21* and *Physical Science 21* working groups was included in the June 1, 2015 Bi-weekly Bulletin. The timelines for this work have now changed.

The Environmental Science 21 working group is scheduled to meet for two days in early September, two days in November and one day in January to develop the *Environmental Science 21* resource package. Meetings may be in either Saskatoon or Regina. The ministry will provide lunch at the meetings and pay for the resource package writer; teachers' organizations will be responsible for their travel, accommodation and substitute costs to attend working group meetings.

School divisions, tribal councils and independent First Nations are invited to submit names of up to three staff members (e.g., teachers, science consultant and/or special education consultant) using the attached nomination form. Nominations are due by Wednesday, May 25, 2016.
